



**2018 Competition Licence**

**01/03/2018 to 28/02/2019**

The 2018 national championship will be run over at least 1 round of competition, and hopefully 2 or more (weather permitting). Each round will be run to the International Rule Book (IRB) format competition - comprising precision (figures and technical freestyle) and ballet. Where an event is a STACK only event there may be two rounds of competition during the weekend – providing conditions allow. Ballet and Precision components of a round may be run on different dates and/or venues. The overall result will be based on the best two precision and ballet scores recorded during the year by each competitor.

In addition to the IRB competition there will also be two other national competitions:

- A freestyle (tricks) competition based on STACKs adaption of the Tricks Party format;
- A ballet competition for competitors flying two or three dual line kites at the same time.

Each of these will consist of at least one round.

In order to compete in any part of the STACK National Championship of 2018, each competitor must be an individual member of STACK and also hold a Competition Licence.

A Competition Licence may be obtained by completing and submitting this form and the appropriate fee to the address below. (Fees contribute toward the cost of running the National Championship.)

- Full competition licence (any/all events including National IRB competition): £20.
- Full competition licence – Novice: £5.
- Full competition licence – Junior: £5.
- Freestyle (tricks) only competition licence: £5.
- Multi-kite ballet only competition licence: £5.

Competitors in their first year of national competition will be allowed to claim “Novice” status.

Competitors under the age of 16 on 1<sup>st</sup> March will be permitted to claim “Junior” status.

Note: in order to compete in the UK Nationals, you have to be a FULL (or Family (Main) member or Junior member) of STACK UK, not an additional family member.

To aid with administration and competition planning, if possible please register for your competition licence at the same time as renewing or applying for STACK UK membership.
